##### *Call to Worship Texts*

##### *Responsive Call to Worship*

*Leader:* Let us lift our voices this hour to praise the triune God who is the source of all beauty in the world he has created and who is inherently beautiful in his being and character.

*People:* O Lord our God, how excellent is your name in all the earth. You have set your glory above the heavens

*Leader:* We praise the beauty of your holiness.

*People:* You are surrounded with majesty and excellence.  
You are arrayed with glory and beauty.

*Leader:* How great is your beauty.

*People:* Open our eyes that we may see and appreciate your beauty.

*Leader:* Let the beauty of the Lord our God be upon us his bride.

*Unison:* One thing have we desired of you, that we will seek after—that we may dwell in your house all the days of our lives, to behold your beauty. We adore, praise, and honor you, the source and perfection of all that is beautiful. In the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen.

### *Prayer of Adoration*

Father God Most High, who are we as unworthy sinners to come into your presence? Yet you have made it possible for us to boldly approach your throne because of the perfect work and righteousness of Jesus Christ which has been credited to our account. We enter your presence because Christ has forgiven us and granted us access.

### *Responsive Call to Worship*

*Prayer of Adoration*

Our loving Lord, receive the adoration which we now offer you through our one and only Savior, Jesus Christ, the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

We come to acknowledge that you by nature are a jealous God. Your name is Jealous. We realize that this is not the ugly, selfish jealousy we see exhibited among humans. But you are properly jealous for the affections of those with whom you have entered into covenant. After creating and redeeming us, you have a right to receive our total loyalty and allegiance.

We acknowledge how it must grieve you when your people turn their backs and give affection and loyalty to idolatrous objects and beings. How patient you have been when your bride has wandered astray and

committed spiritual adultery. You are rightly jealous because you love us and care so much for us as our Creator and Redeemer.

So we desire to give you all the praise and adoration you deserve with all our hearts, souls, and minds. We love you and desire to serve you. Receive our sincere worship as we raise our voices to pray through Christ the prayer he taught us, saying, Our Father . . .

### *Prayer of Adoration*

Lord God and beloved Father, we come into your presence with hearts overflowing with love. We recall your many demonstrations of unchanging love for us. Year after year you have acted in love toward us, even during those periods when we have failed to return your love as we should have. You have loved us with everlasting love from before the foundation of the world.
